I have some steps to improve students' writing skills in my class. First, at the beginning of each lesson, I spend a short amount of time letting students talk about a social topic related to what they've learned from other subjects. Second, before writing about the topic, I'd encourage students to do brainstorming and write important words and phrases freely. Later, they can arrange this information in order and make whole sentences from it including their thoughts and ideas. Finally, in pairs or groups, students read or listen to each other's writing and offer feedback. These steps would increase students' motivation for the next writing assignment. (106words)
